ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSES TO  
CHAIRMAN'S INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 2

(Issued February 12, 2020)

On February 4, 2020, the Commission issued Chairman's Information Request No. 2 seeking responses by the Postal Service by February 11, 2020, and providing for an opportunity for any party to file replies to the Postal Service's answers by February 18, 2020.<sup>1</sup>

On February 11, 2020, the Postal Service filed a motion requesting an extension of time to file responses to CHIR No. 2.<sup>2</sup> The Postal Service requests an extension until February 18, 2020. Motion at 1. The Postal Service states that it is in the process of coordinating with officials in Seattle, Washington regarding its responses, but is encountering delays. *Id.* The Postal Service states that this extension will not prejudice

any party and does not oppose additional time for Complainant to file any responsive comments. *Id.*

In consideration of the Postal Service's request, the Commission shall extend the deadline for the responses to CHIR No. 2 until February 18, 2020. Responses to the Postal Service's answers (and limited in scope only to the answers) are now due by February 24, 2020.

*It is ordered:*

1. The United States Postal Service Motion for Extension of Time to File Response to Questions 1-4 of Chairman's Information Request No. 2, filed February 11, 2020, is granted. The Postal Service shall file its responses to Chairman's Information Request No. 2 by February 18, 2020.
2. Responses to the Postal Service's answers (and limited in scope only to the answers) are due to be filed by February 24, 2020.
