**NOTICE OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE OF FILING ADDITIONAL RATE-RELATED INFORMATION TO INBOUND COMPETITIVE MULTI-SERVICE IRA-USPS AGREEMENT**  
(June 5, 2020)

In Order No. 5514,<sup>1</sup> the Postal Regulatory Commission (Commission or PRC) established Docket No. CP2020-141 to consider the United States Postal Service's (Postal Service) notice filed on May 15, 2020 (Notice) in this matter.<sup>2</sup> In its Notice, the Postal Service included signature pages to the "Interconnect Remuneration Agreement USPS and Specified Postal Operators" (referred to as the "IRA-USPS Agreement") executed by certain foreign postal operators (FPOs). The Postal Service also stated in its Notice that it will update this docket should additional FPOs accede to the IRA-USPS Agreement.<sup>3</sup> On May 26, 2020, June 3, 2020, and June 4, 2020, the Postal Service notified the Commission of additional signatories to the IRA-USPS Agreement.<sup>4</sup>

As the Postal Service noted in its Notice and pursuant to Annex 2 in the IRA-USPS Agreement, beginning with rates that will be in effect in 2021, any party to the IRA-USPS Agreement may change its delivery rates by communicating the new rates to the International Post Corporation (IPC) by the 1st of June of the year preceding its application.<sup>5</sup> In accordance with this term in the agreement, two counterparty FPOs have communicated new delivery rates to the IPC. The Postal Service files as Attachments 1 and 2 to this notice additional FPO-specific rate information for these two counterparty FPOs. A non-public preface is included with each attachment.

The Postal Service maintains that the identities of the counterparty FPOs to the IRA-USPS Agreement, rates, and other sensitive commercial information in Attachments 1 and 2 should remain confidential and incorporates by reference the Application for Non-Public Treatment filed with its Notice in this docket.<sup>6</sup> Redacted copies, where appropriate, of these attachments are filed publicly, while unredacted versions are filed under seal for the Commission's review.
