**NOTICE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE REGARDING THE
BELLVILLE VILLAGE POST OFFICE**
(August 27, 2020)

The United States Postal Service (Postal Service) hereby gives notice to the Postal Regulatory Commission (Commission) that as of today's date, the Postal Service has decided to pause the closing of the Bellville Village Post Office (BVPO). This decision is related to the Postal Service's August 2020 announcement that it will be pausing certain activities until after the election in November 2020.

Although the current status of the Postal Service's decision to close the BVPO has changed, this does not change the legal status of the Postal Service's motion to dismiss the City of Bellville's appeal of the Postal Service's determination to close the BVPO.¹ The Postal Service maintains that for the reasons provided in its Motion to Dismiss, the Commission lacks jurisdiction to hear the City of Bellville's appeal. The Postal Service continues to respectfully request, therefore, that the Commission dismiss, with prejudice, the City of
