**USPS MOTION FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF
NOTICE OF FILING PMNPR-2 CONTRACT WITH
SERIAL NUMBER ENDING: 0824**
(March 31, 2021)

The United States Postal Service moves for late acceptance of its notice of filing for the Priority Mail—Non-Published Rates - 2 (PMNPR-2) customer agreement with serial number ending in 0824, which the Postal Service has filed today in this docket.

Commission Order No. 5562 (June 25, 2020) requires that notice of every new PMNPR-2 contract be filed within a reasonable time, *e.g.*, within ten days of the contract's effective date. Because of an apparent glitch in the Postal Service's internal contract tracking software, an effective date was established for this contract on March 18, 2021, without the system notifying appropriate personnel in the usual manner. The Postal Service discovered this error this morning in a periodic manual review of all PMNPR-2 contracts. No other PMNPR-2 contracts were affected by this error.

The Postal Service regrets the brief delay in filing the notice, but submits that no party has been materially prejudiced.
