I am writing today to express my frustration and concern for the USPO. As a rural American, the post office is my life line in so many ways I use to take for granted.

I realized how wonderful and efficient it was only after Mr. DeJoy took office and changed so many things that my mail delivery was very late. I lost confidence in sending mail hoping it would arrive at an appropriate time. I decided to not use the post office during the pandemic because I did not trust that my vote would be counted. I don't fully understand why he made so many changes which seem to have weakened the postal service but I do know that after listening to him in Congressional hearings, I feel he is ill equipped for the job of Post Master General.

It seems he is very interested in making the postal service work inefficiently so he can leverage his power and invite private enterprise to take over significant postal responsibilities.
