Dear Ms. Barker:

In connection with the Postal Regulatory Commission's rules pertaining to periodic reports, 39 C.F.R. § 3055, the United States Postal Service (Postal Service) encloses copies of the additional following reports for Quarter 3 of FY 2021:

1. Quarterly Performance for Special Services, including copies of the related service performance reports posted on usps.com; and
2. the PDF files for the Quarterly Performance for Single-Piece First-Class Mail International and related Service Variance reports posted on usps.com.

The Postal Service is filing these reports today, four business day out of time, due to the need to confirm key details with personnel. The Postal Service submits that no party was prejudiced by this brief delay.

The reports related to Special Services present results broken down by the Postal Service's current organizational structure of four Areas and 50 Districts. Displaying these reports based on the Postal Service's legacy Areas and Districts has proven challenging to maintain; this would require costly and time-consuming material changes to certain reporting systems. Additionally, in accordance with Order No. 5576, the Postal Service's filing in this matter includes only internal data for International Inbound and Outbound Mail and Return Receipt/Green Card products.¹
