<sup>1</sup> As explained in the Audits themselves, and as done for all quarters of FY22, ICF prepared two versions of the FY22 Q4 report (Legacy and Reorganization versions). The Reorganization version reflects the change from 7 Areas and 67 Districts to 4 Areas and 50 Districts. As it has also done for all quarters of FY22, the Postal Service likewise prepared two versions of its Response to correspond to the two different versions of the Audit. Beginning with FY23 data, the Postal Service plans to submit the quarterly audits and audit responses using only the current (Reorganization) structure. This approach is also consistent with the Commission's proposed rules. See Order No. 6275 (at 24), Docket No. RM2022-7.
