

Pursuant to P.O. Ruling No. MC2000-2/3,<sup>1</sup> the Office of the Consumer Advocate ("OCA") hereby notifies the Presiding Officer of its expectation concerning oral cross-examination of Postal Service witnesses on January 12 and 13. OCA intends to cross-examine witnesses Plunkett (on USPS-T-1 and USPS-T-5), Poellnitz (USPS-T-2), and Lim (USPS-T-3). OCA's expectation is that cross-examination on USPS-T-1 will be moderate to heavy; on USPS-T-5 moderate; on USPS-T-2 light (possibly

unnecessary);<sup>2</sup> and on USPS-T-3 moderate to heavy.




