In response to Presiding Officer's Ruling No. 4, the Postal Service is providing two sets of the designated interrogatory responses referred to in paragraph 2 and identified in Attachment A to the Stipulation and Agreement filed on December 20, 1999; and an attestation of witness Taufique concerning his testimony and responses.
