
The interrogatory is stated verbatim and is followed by the revised response.


OCA/USPS-8. Please refer to the attachment. Please provide the cost of preparing, processing, transporting, and delivering this mail.

RESPONSE: No study of the cost of processing, transporting or delivery of this particular mailing has been performed. Its mail processing, transportation and delivery cost characteristics should be similar to those of other Standard A Saturation ECR mail pieces.

The cost of printing and preparing the mail piece is estimated to be approximately \$2.5 million.
