

Cox Sampling is a major user of the U.S. mails, particularly Standard (A) Mail, in terms of both quantity of items mailed and costs of postage, and would be significantly affected by the rate and classification proposals of the Postal Service.

At this stage of the proceedings, it is unknown whether the Postal Service's request for mail classification changes and rate increases, as proposed, is in accordance with the Postal Reorganization Act. *See* 39 U.S.C. sections 3622 and 3623.


