SUBMISSION OF MATERIAL DESIGNATED FROM DOCKET NO. MC98-1
AS EVIDENCE IN THE DOCKET NO. MC2000-2 PROCEEDING
(February 18, 2000)

Pursuant to P.O. Ruling No. MC2000-2/7,¹ the Office of the Consumer Advocate ("OCA") hereby submits the following testimony and cross-examination from Docket No. MC98-1 as evidence in the Docket No. MC2000-2 proceeding. In accordance with the directive in Ruling No. 7, the OCA has not included pages 1265-72 from transcript volume 6, MC98-1. In the Postal Service's Motion for Designation of Testimony and Cross-Examination from Previous Docket as Evidence in Commission Docket No. MC2000-2,² the Postal Service moved to have USPS-T-4 (Docket No. MC98-1) and Tr. 2/428-79 as evidence in the instant proceeding. The OCA also believed it appropriate to include in the instant record other responses that witness Rothschild made to OCA interrogatories in Docket No. MC98-1, specifically her responses to interrogatories

OCA/USPS-T4-36-38, 44-45, found in Tr. 6/1265-72. Consequently, the OCA designated these transcript pages for inclusion in the record of Docket No. MC2000-2.³

At the January 13, 2000, hearing, the Postal Service expressed a wish to keep all of the Rothschild written cross-examination together. The OCA agreed that it was a good idea to do so. In this way, the transcript pages identified by the Presiding Officer became "redundant." In accordance with the Presiding Officer's ruling, they have been omitted from the two packets of evidentiary material submitted today.


