

## MOTION FOR CONSIDERATION OF STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT (February 24, 2000)

The United States Postal Service hereby submits an executed Stipulation and Agreement, representing a negotiated settlement by the signatories of all issues raised in this proceeding related to the experimental changes in the Domestic Mail Classification Schedule and Rate Schedules proposed in this Docket. The signatories request that when the Postal Rate Commission issues its Opinion and Recommended Decision in this Docket that it recommend the changes in the Domestic Mail Classification Schedule and Rate Schedules contained in the Attachment which accompanies the Stipulation and Agreement.

At this time, Pitney Bowes, Inc., and the Office of the Consumer Advocate have authorized the Postal Service to represent that each supports the Stipulation and Agreement and this motion. The Postal Service wishes to thank these participants for their cooperative and cordial efforts in reaching this settlement and urges the Commission to recommend the experimental Domestic Mail Classification Schedule and Rate Schedule changes agreed to by the signatories.
