

**MPA/USPS-T12-7.** Please confirm that ALDRAN.HQ059T01.CITY.PQ4FY97 contains a listing of all city carrier routes in the USPS system as the end of PQ 4 1997. If this is incorrect, please explain what the file does contain.

**RESPONSE:**

No. The file ALDRAN.HQ059T01.CITY.PQ4FY97 was created about six weeks before the end of PQ 4. It contains all city carrier letter routes in the USPS system at the time the file was created. It also includes some phantom routes, PO Boxes, uniques (a five digit ZIP Code for one customer), and military routes. It excludes parcel post routes, collection routes, and relay routes.


