TO WITNESS RAYMOND (ERRATUM)

On March 17, 2000, the Postal Service filed its Opposition to the MPA Motion to Compel Answers to interrogatories MPA/USPS-T13-6, 7, 10, 12, 14, 17, 19, 45-47, 50 and 56 to witness Raymond. Although the document contains several typographical errors, only one is of sufficient magnitude to warrant correction. In the second-to-last sentence on page 11, in reference to MPA interrogatory 17, the following phrase appears: "somewhere between one hundred and two thousand dollars." This phrase should read: "somewhere between one hundred and two *hundred* thousand dollars."

The Postal Service regrets any confusion that the omission of this important word may have caused.
