Except for the tables identified as "spreadsheets" in Part V, and all the tables in Part VIII, the SAS output data consist of the tables shown in USPS-LR-I-106 (many SAS tables have been reformatted to Excel). The SAS output tables are generated in four different data processing streams, each one of which starts with the IOCS tally file. Also, see my response to TW-USPS-T17-2 b and c.
