

ADVO/USPS-T3-14. The City Carrier Cost System (CCS) is used to estimate the number of possible and actual stops and deliveries for Single Delivery Residential, Multiple Delivery Residential, and Business and Mixed for each of the eight city letter carrier route types.

- (b) For each delivery type for each of the eight route types, please provide (i) the 1998 annual number of possible and actual deliveries estimates and (ii) their standard deviations, confidence intervals, and coefficients of variation.
