MOTION OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE TO RESCHEDULE HEARING  
APPEARANCE OF WITNESS YEZER  
(April 6, 00)

Presiding Officer's Ruling No. R2000-1/19 scheduled witnesses for hearings on the Postal Service's direct case. Witness Yezer is scheduled as the fourth of five witnesses on Friday, April 28, 2000.

This scheduling accommodated the Postal Service request for witness Yezer. However, subsequent to the Postal Service's provision of information to the Commission prior to issuance of Ruling 19, witness Yezer found that he has a conflict on April 28 involving a school matter with his fifth grade son. Also, the undersigned counsel has learned that two dates which he had blocked out for a family matter have become free.

Consequently, the Postal Service moves that witness Yezer's hearing appearance be changed from April 28 to one of the following (in no specific order of preference):

- 1) April 26 as the first witness (witness Yezer must return to the George Washington University campus by 3:00 p.m. to teach on Wednesdays). Witness Frong is the only other witness scheduled for this date.
- 2) May 1 (earlier is preferred although not required);


- 3) May 3 (no other witness is now scheduled for that date);


