Pursuant to Section 30(e)(3) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, United Parcel Service ("UPS") hereby gives notice that it intends to conduct oral cross-examination of United States Postal Service witness Kingsley on the following subjects: the acceptance of parcel shipments by postal personnel (including the acceptance of drop shipments and the verification of drop shipment mailings), USPS-T-10 at 23-24; the flow of parcels through the Postal Service's processing and delivery system, USPS-T-10 at 19; future systems for parcel processing and delivery, USPS-T-10 at 22-23; delivery operations for parcels, USPS-T-10 at 24-28; the management incentive system, USPS-T-10 at 28; staffing for parcel deliveries, USPS-T-10 at 30-32; space planning

issues, USPS-T-10 at 32-35; and clarification of and expansion on Ms. Kingsley's interrogatory responses.


