The United States Postal Service hereby provides the response of witness Hunter to the following interrogatory of United Parcel Service, filed on April 5, 2000.




RESPONSE OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE WITNESS HUNTER
TO INTERROGATORY OF UNITED PARCEL SERVICE

UPS/USPS-T5-91. Refer to UPS/USPS-T5-30, which requests the SAS logs for each of three jobs and four quarters for the RPW program, LR-I-194. The Postal Service has objected to this request on the grounds of burden and redundancy. To reduce the burden to the Postal Service, UPS is narrowing its request to the following: Provide the correct master rate table input data for Job 2 to allow replication for all mail categories.

RESPONSE. No changes are made to the master rate table input data files labeled BRPW57-60.TXT and BRPW62-64.TXT provided in USPS-LR-I-194/R2000-1. A minor update was made after the FY 1998 period to the Standard Mail (A) master rate file affecting the single VIP Code 08689 for the October 5, 1997 rate schedule. This update was reflected in the file labeled BRPW61.TXT. The original unchanged file is provided in USPS-LR-I-303/R2000-1.
