

Pursuant to Section 30(e)(3) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, United Parcel Service ("UPS") hereby gives notice that it intends to conduct oral cross-examination of United States Postal Service witness Degen on the following subjects: the role of different facilities in the postal network (USPS-T-16 at 10-30); fixed vs. variable costs (USPS-T-16 at 8-10); the nature, extent, and impact of volume growth (USPS-T-16 at 24-30); interactions between MODS activities within and among facilities (USPS-T-16 at 30-51); evaluation of the econometric results (USPS-T-16 at 51-55); cost

pools and distribution keys (USPS-T-16 at 55); and clarification of and expansion on witness Degen's interrogatory responses.


