NOTICE OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE OF INTENTION TO OBJECT  
TO UNITED PARCEL SERVICE  
INTERROGATORY TO THE POSTAL SERVICE  
(May 1, 2000)

On April 20, 2000 United Parcel Service (UPS) filed interrogatories UPS/USPS-19-35, the last of which constitutes another inquiry by United Parcel Service into records underlying RPW data. The Postal Service plans to incorporate its objection to this interrogatory together with its objections to UPS/USPS-12-15, which it hopes to be able to file tomorrow. The reason for the delay is an effort to identify some means of permitting inquiry into underlying records that does not require months of effort.
