
NOTICE BY UNITED PARCEL SERVICE OF AGREEMENT  
ON PRODUCTION OF INFORMATION REQUESTED  
IN INTERROGATORIES UPS/USPS-T10-24 AND 32  
TO WITNESS KINGSLEY AND NOTICE OF  
WITHDRAWAL OF MOTION TO COMPEL  
(May 16, 2000)

On March 21, 2000, United Parcel Service ("UPS") filed interrogatories UPS/USPS-T10-24 and 32 directed to United States Postal Service Witness Kingsley. The Postal Service filed an objection to these interrogatories on March 31, 2000, in response to which UPS filed a motion to compel on April 11, 2000. On April 20, 2000, the Postal Service filed its Response of United States Postal Service to Motion of United Parcel Service to Compel Production of Information and Documents Requested in Interrogatories UPS/USPS-T10-24 and 32 to Witness Kingsley. On May 2, 2000, the Postal Service filed the following Category 4 library reference: USPS-LR-I-314, Form 8125 Materials Produced Under Protective Conditions Pursuant to Presiding Officer's Ruling No. R2000-1/55.

UPS is willing to accept the documents produced to answer UPS/USPS-T10-24 and 32 in the form proposed by the Postal Service. Therefore, UPS withdraws its April 11, 2000, motion to compel.


