Please confirm that IBM retail terminals installed in Troy, Michigan, will indicate that the service standard for mail from Troy, Michigan, to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, Saint Louis, Missouri, and New York, New York, is three days for First-Class Mail and two days for Priority Mail. If you do not confirm, please explain.

RESPONSE:

Confirmed that IBM retail terminals installed in Troy, MI (480) will indicate that the service standard for mail from Troy, MI (480) to Philadelphia, PA (191), Saint Louis, MO (631), and New York, NY (100), is three days for First-Class Mail and two days for Priority Mail.
