



- a. Please confirm that in your revised filing in LR420, Folder PT7.XLS, the “total unit cost” over all weight ranges for First Class single piece letters has fallen by over one cent since your original filing in LR-I-91 revised, Section 1, page 1, from 20.5 cents to 19.1 cents.
- b. Please confirm that in your revised filing in LR420, Folder PT7.XLS, the “total unit cost” for the first ounce of First Class single piece letters has fallen almost two cents since your original filing in LR-I-91 revised, Section 1, page 1, from 19.6 cents to 17.8 cents.
- c. In light of your answers to a. and b. above, do you intend to pass these cost reductions through in a revised and lower rate for First Class single piece letter mail by one cent relative to your initial filing? If not, why not?
