ADVO, INC. RE-DESIGNATION OF PREVIOUSLY-DESIGNATED  
INTERROGATORY RESPONSES OF NATIONAL NEWSPAPER ASSOCIATION  
WITNESS MAX HEATH FOR INCLUSION IN THE EVIDENTIARY RECORD, OR  
IN THE ALTERNATIVE, MOTION TO INCORPORATE INTO THE RECORD

On July 5, 2000, ADVO, Inc. (Advo) filed designations of written cross-examination of National Newspaper Association witness Max Heath, designating the witness's responses to ADVO/NAA-T1-1-2 for inclusion in the evidentiary record. Two sets of the designated responses accompanied Advo's designations. Witness Heath appeared and testified at the hearings held on July 10th. However, in reviewing the transcript of that hearing, Advo has discovered that its timely-filed designations were, apparently inadvertently, not included in the transcript.

Accordingly, Advo hereby re-designates those responses for inclusion in the transcript volume for post-hearing designated materials as prescribed by Presiding Officer's Ruling No. R2000-1/105. Alternatively, to the extent that these previously-designated interrogatory responses might technically not be considered "post-hearing" responses under Ruling 105, Advo moves that they be included in the evidentiary record and transcribed.

Two sets of these designated interrogatory responses are being contemporaneously filed with the Commission.
