**RESPONSE OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE TO
INTERROGATORY OF UNITED PARCEL SERVICE**

UPS/USPS-58. (a) Provide the proportion of PostECS transactions to date where the sender had an email address containing a top level domain of .com, .org, .net, or .edu in the domain name of the sender's email address and the message was left for the recipient to retrieve on a server located in the United States.

RESPONSE:

All *attached files* to PosteCS messages from USPS PosteCS registered customers having e-mail addresses containing the top level domain of .com, .org, .net, or .edu in the domain name of the senders' email addresses are left for recipients to retrieve on server(s) located in the United States; however, the *notification message component* of PosteCS transactions could reside on any server in the world, and the Postal Service has no data indicating what proportion of such messages are retrieved from servers in the United States or elsewhere.
