Pursuant to Section 20 of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 39 C.F.R. § 3001.20, United Parcel Service ("UPS") hereby gives notice of its intervention as a full participant in this proceeding and states the following in support of its intervention:


1. UPS provides delivery services throughout the United States via air and ground operations. UPS also provides international delivery services.
2. UPS competes with the United States Postal Service and is concerned about and affected by the application of the Postal Reorganization Act of 1970, as amended, 39 U.S.C. § 101 et seq., in all areas where the Postal Service competes with private enterprise, including UPS. These areas include expedited letter and parcel delivery services such as Priority Mail and related service offerings such as delivery confirmation service, which are the subject of the Postal Service's request initiating this proceeding.
3. UPS is also a substantial user of postal services, especially First Class Mail.
4. As a competitor of the Postal Service and as a user of postal services, UPS will be affected by and is interested in the changes proposed by the Postal Service

in this proceeding. UPS believes that the Postal Service's proposal to offer a service for free during the high volume Christmas mailing period violates the Postal Reorganization Act.

5. UPS requests a hearing in this proceeding. If hearings are held, UPS presently intends to participate actively in them.

WHEREFORE, United Parcel Service gives notice of its intervention in this proceeding.

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
