Opinion and Recommended Decision Approving Stipulation and Agreement, Docket No. MC2000-1 at 15. PostCom believes that the Postal Service is quite right in its belief that the experiment should not be permitted to lapse by the passage of time before the Commission has the opportunity

to adjudicate the request for a permanent classification that is pending in R20001-1.
