The Authority is a corporate municipal instrumentality and political subdivision of the State of New York with its principal office located at 333 Earle Ovington Blvd., Suite 403, Uniondale, New York. The Authority is engaged primarily in the purchase and distribution at retail of electricity in the New York counties of Nassau and Suffolk (with certain limited exceptions) and in a small portion of Queens County known as the Rockaways. The area served contains a population of approximately three million persons. In connection with the provision of electric service, the Authority is a large user of mail services, primarily for customers' billing and Qualified Business Reply Mail.


3. On September 24, 2001, the United States Postal Service ("USPS") filed a request for a recommended decision regarding a USPS proposal to change rates and fees for postal services. The Authority has an interest in the matters to be heard and decided in this proceeding such that its intervention is necessary and appropriate.

4. The Authority hereby indicates that it will be a limited participator in this proceeding.


