The NALC is recognized as the exclusive collective bargaining representative of USPS employees in the city letter carrier craft nationwide, pursuant to 39 U.S.C. §1203. In accordance with §1206 of the Act, the NALC has entered into successive, nationwide collective bargaining agreements with the United States Postal Service. The proposed changes in rates and fees will have a significant effect on the USPS workers represented by the NALC.

As a clearly interested party, the NALC should be allowed the opportunity to conduct discovery aimed at elucidating the issues, inquiring into the impact of the proposed measure on postal operations, and carrying out its statutory obligation to represent city letter carrier craft employees in matters affecting their employment. The NALC affirmatively requests a hearing and affirmatively states its intention to participate actively in such hearing.
