
NOTICE BY FEDERAL EXPRESS CORPORATION
OF INTERVENTION AS A LIMITED PARTICIPANT
UNDER COMMISSION RULE 20A
25 JULY 1997

Pursuant to Rule 20a of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 39 C.F.R. § 3001.20a, Federal Express Corporation ("FedEx") hereby gives notice of its intervention as a limited participant in this proceeding and states the following in support of its intervention:

1. FedEx provides express delivery services throughout the United States and between the United States and most foreign countries. FedEx's services compete directly and indirectly with services of the United States Postal Service.
2. FedEx is also a substantial user of the services of the U.S. Postal Service.
3. As a competitor of the Postal Service and as a user of postal services, *FedEx will be affected by and is interested in the changes in the classifications and rates proposed by the Postal Service in this proceeding. In particular, FedEx is concerned about and affected by the application of the Postal Reorganization Act of*

1970, as amended, 39 U.S.C. § 101 et seq., in areas where the Postal Service competes with private enterprise, including FedEx. These areas include express delivery services as well as ancillary services which are often purchased with the basic delivery service.
