**CLARIFICATION OF NOTICE  
TRANSMITTING RESPONSE OF  
UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE WITNESS FRONK  
TO NDMS INTERROGATORY T32-22**

On Friday, August 22, 1997, the United States Postal Service filed the response of witness Fronk to NDMS interrogatory T32-22.

That interrogatory was one of seven directed to witness Fronk on August 8, 1997, by NDMS. All of the others (T32-17 through T32-21 and T32-23) were redirected by witness Fronk either to witnesses Moden, Hatfield, or to the Postal Service for response. The final paragraph on the cover page transmitting witness Fronk's response to T32-22 attempted to clarify which interrogatories went where. Sad to say, that paragraph came close, but did not clarify things. It should have read as follows:

Interrogatories T32-17, T32-18c-e, T32-19 and T32-20 have been redirected to the Postal Service for response. The response to T32-19 was filed on August 18, 1997. The other responses are being filed today. Interrogatories T32-18a-b, T32-21 and T32-23a were redirected to witness Moden for response. Those responses were filed on August 20, 1997. Interrogatory T32-23b was redirected to witness Hatfield for response. That response is being filed today.
