In the United States Postal Service's ("Postal Service") opposition to United Parcel Service's ("UPS") motion to compel production of information and materials requested in interrogatories UPS/USPS-T33-1(c) and 2(a)-(c), the Postal Service requests that the Commission defer its ruling on the motion to compel until such time as counsel for UPS has reviewed the redacted version of the PMPC contract, which has recently been filed by the Postal Service as a library reference. UPS submits this notice to inform the Commission that it has no objection to the Commission deferring a ruling on the motion as requested by the Postal Service.

After counsel for UPS has had an opportunity to review the redacted PMPC contract, UPS will inform the Commission and the Postal Service whether it will withdraw its motion to compel, or request the Commission to rule on the motion.

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
