The United States Postal Service hereby provides its revised response to the following interrogatory: OCA/USPS-121, filed on October 24, 2001. The original response, filed on November 7, 2001, provided the average delivery time for Priority and First Class Mail to Post Offices identified in OCA/USPS-27. Due to a rounding error, the averages provided were incorrect. The actual averages for Priority and First Class Mail are 4.8 and 5.2, respectively.


The interrogatory is stated verbatim and is followed by the response.


- (a) What is the average time it takes to deliver a Priority Mail piece to the Post Offices identified in the Postal Service's response to OCA/USPS-27?
- (b) What is the average time it takes to deliver a First-Class single piece letter to the Post Offices identified in the Postal Service's response to OCA/USPS-27?

RESPONSE:

- (a) Approximately 4.8 days.
- (b) Approximately 5.2 days.
