### ORDER GRANTING INTERVENOR STATUS

(Issued December 4, 2001)

On November 9, 2001, the Envelope Manufacturers Association (EMA) submitted a Notice of its desire to intervene as a limited participant in this case accompanied by a motion for an order authorizing late intervention. The date for intervention as of right was October 24, 2001. There has been no opposition to EMA's request and intervention as a limited participant shall be allowed.


On October 26, 2001, American Postal Workers Union, AFL-CIO (APWU) submitted a Notice of its desire to intervene as a full participant in this case. Order No. 1329 granted intervention, but incorrectly indicated that APWU sought limited participant status. APWU has full party status in this case.

It is ordered:

1. The Motion of Envelope Manufacturers Association for an Order Authorizing Late Filing of its Notice of Intervention, filed November 9, 2001, is granted subject to compliance with rulings and orders already issued.
2. American Postal Workers Union, AFL-CIO has full party status in this case.
