
MOTION FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of its response to the following interrogatory of United Parcel Service: UPS/USPS-t1-1(e), filed on November 9, 2001. This response was delayed by inadvertence of counsel. Witness Shaw's response to the other parts of that interrogatory were filed on November 21, 2001. Undersigned counsel had prepared the institutional response to UPS/USPS-t1-1(e) in final form, but apparently in the rush of other work, did not actually file the response. 
