SIXTH REPORT OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
AS SETTLEMENT COORDINATOR
(January 4, 2002)

On December 26, 2001, the Postal Service filed a revised Stipulation and Agreement for settlement of the instant docket.¹ The Postal Service also gave notice that its Board of Governors had established January 3, 2002, as the date on which parties should submit signatures to this agreement to the Postal Service.




