Since the wording of the DMCS that applies to the handling of First-Class Mail applies equally to the Letters and Sealed Parcels Subclass, the Cards Subclass, and the Priority Mail Subclass, the differences that apply between the three subclasses are relevant to this case and are necessary to fully evaluate the methods by which the service standards meet the requirements of the DMCS which are an indication of the statutory requirements.

For the reasons given, the Postal Service should be compelled to provide the answer to this interrogatory.
