RESPONSE OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE  
TO PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING NO. R2001-1/33  
(January 16, 2002)

On January 15, 2002, Presiding Officer's Ruling No. R2001-1/33 directed the provision of an answer to UPS/USPS-T28-5 in response to an uncontested motion to compel filed by United Parcel Service.

A response to UPS/USPS-T28-5 by Postal Service witness Moeller was actually filed on November 21, 2001. Unfortunately, the cover page prepared by undersigned counsel transmitting that response erroneously indicated that the first interrogatory in the set was UPS/USPS-T28-6, when in fact the set included the response to UPS/USPS-T28-5.
