LISTING BY UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE  
OF OUTSTANDING DISCOVERY,  
IN RESPONSE TO PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING NO. R2001-1/44  
(February 7, 2002)

The United States Postal Service hereby provides a listing of outstanding discovery directed to the Postal Service, as requested by Presiding Officer's Ruling No. R2001-1/44. That Ruling, issued January 31, 2002, suspended outstanding discovery directed to the Postal Service, in light of the pending Settlement in this Docket.<sup>1</sup> The Ruling requested that the Postal Service file a listing of all outstanding discovery directed to it, by the sooner of today or the date it files to withdraw from the settlement.

Presiding Officer's Ruling No. R2001-1/47, issued February 4, 2002, identified all discovery to the Postal Service for which there is an outstanding motion to compel. That Ruling concluded that consideration of these motions to compel would be held in abeyance while the Settlement and related issues are pending before the Commission.

The Postal Service has identified the following additional discovery that is affected by the discovery suspension.


