**THIRD NOTICE OF INTERNATIONAL MAIL
DATA REQUIREMENTS FOR FY 2001**

(Issued May 10, 2002)

In order to help the Commission prepare the report required by 39 U.S.C. Section 3663, on the costs, volumes, and revenues of the Postal Service's international mail services, the Service is requested to provide the following information.


1. Item 10 in the Commission's First Notice of International Mail Data Requirements referred to changes that the Postal Service had made to the rate structure of certain international mail categories in FY 2001, and asked the Postal Service to provide its estimates of the changes in average revenue per piece that it expected would result. The Postal Service provided an indirect response to this request. In order to better identify the changes in average revenue per piece that the Postal Service expected to result from these structural changes, please provide any estimates of before and after rates volume and revenue by mail category that were provided to Postal Service management to support the staff's proposed reclassifications and rate changes that became effective January 7, 2001. Please provide any associated attributable cost estimates as well.
2. The information submitted on March 15, 2001 included the electronic files used to produce the FY 2001 International CRA and the Cost Segments and

Components reports. These files are i.dat, a.dat, b.dat, ititle.dat, and tranhead.dat. Please provide the same electronic files used to produce the FY 2001 Domestic CRA – PRC Version. Please also include the files, commonly referred to as A, B, and F, that list the operating string commands that produce the C Report from the manual input.
