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

They have an interest in the proposed Negotiated Service Agreement, and the procedures employed in its considerations, and could be significantly affected by such proposed rate and classification changes.

At this stage of the proceeding, it is unknown whether the Postal Service's request for rate and classification changes, as proposed, is in accordance with the Postal Reorganization Act. *See* 39 U.S.C. sections 3622 and 3623.

APMU takes no position at this time on the need for a hearing.


