

VPDA members have an interest in the proposed Negotiated Service Agreement, and the procedures employed in its considerations, and could be significantly affected by the rate and classification proposals of the United States Postal Service.

At this stage of the proceedings, it is unknown whether the Postal Service's request for mail classification changes and rate increases, as proposed, is in accordance with the Postal Reorganization Act. *See* 39 U.S.C. sections 3622 and 3623.
