

2 42,000 active and retired postmasters in the United States. NAPUS members derive their  
3 livelihood from their employment with the Postal Service, or receive annuities and health  
4 coverage as a result of prior employment with the Postal Service.
- 5 3. NAPUS represents the approximately 27,000 postmasters who manage individual postal  
6 facilities throughout the nation. Moreover, NAPUS members serve as the vital link between  
7 postal reliant communities and U.S. postal policy. Actions taken by the Postal Service to  
8 alter postal classifications, rates, and fees for special services affect the working conditions  
9 of NAPUS members and impact communities in which postmasters serve.

11 decided in this proceeding of such nature that its intervention is necessary and appropriate.


