NOTICE CONCERNING FILING OF REVISIONS TO  
UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE LIBRARY REFERENCES  
C2001-3/11 AND C2001-3/13 [ERRATA]  
(October 30, 2002)

The United States Postal Service hereby gives notice that it is filing revisions to the following two Library References previously filed in this proceeding:

USPS LR C2001-3/11 and C2001-3/13.

C2001-3/11

Filed on September 30, 2002, in response to DFC/USPS-9, Library Reference C2001-3/11 consisted of a hard copy of ODIS First-Class Mail time-in-transit data for district-to-district origin-destination pairs downgraded from 2-day to 3-day service before and after service standard changes for specifically identified postal administrative districts. The contents of the Library Reference were marked as pages 2 through 91.

As revised today, page 1, a guide to interpreting the data, has been added to the Library Reference. In addition, as revised today, all district-to-district origin-destination pairs for which it was deemed that data do not permit a statistically valid estimate are now clearly marked "N/A". Also, where appropriate, errors in the original version of C2001-3/11 are corrected. As a consequence, some of the scores originally reported in the Library Reference have been replaced by the "N/A" designation. Finally, certain origin-destination pairs outside the scope of the request (but included in the original version of C2001-3/11) are now omitted in the revised version.

C2001-3/13

As filed on October 21, 2002, Library Reference C2001-3/13 consisted of a diskette containing two electronic files, one of which (fredshalf.xls) is an electronic version of Library Reference C2001-3/11. A revised version of this particular electronic file (now in two parts) is being filed today in revised Library Reference C2001-3/13 to conform to the revised hard-copy version of Library Reference C2001-3/11 described above.
