ORDER ON EVIDENTIARY RECORD

On July 28, 2003, the Postal Service filed a Stipulation and Agreement (settlement) on behalf of itself and other signatories in resolution of all issues in this proceeding. Paragraph 2 of Part II of the settlement identifies the material that the signatories agree provides substantial record evidence supporting and justifying a Recommended Decision on changes to the Domestic Mail Classification Schedule and related Rate Schedules 521 and 522, and Fee Schedule 1000. This material includes: the Request and attachments thereto; the direct testimony, as revised if applicable, of Postal Service witnesses Gullo (USPS-T-1), Eggleston (USPS-T-2), Kiefer (USPS-T-3) and Wittnebel (USPS-T-4); data collection plan; and written cross-examination designated below:
