SUPPLEMENTAL COMMENTS ON NSAs VS. PILOT TESTS
(October 10, 2003)

The Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) hereby asks that Supplemental Comments filed after the Commission's established Comment date of September 29, 2003, be accepted for consideration. On September 29, 2003, when OCA's initial comments were filed, OCA was unaware of the Commission's position on its lack of jurisdiction over Postal Service pilot tests. The potential confusion between customer specific pilot tests and customer specific NSAs only became apparent yesterday as a result of OCA's reading of Commission Order No. 1385.¹
