This library reference contains 23 inter-linked Excel spreadsheets that perform the analysis of Periodicals costs and volumes described in TW et al.-T-2. The role of each spreadsheet is described in the proffered testimony. |

This library reference contains 3 Excel spreadsheets that develop the Outside County Periodicals rates proposed for non-letters described in TW et al.-T-1. The role of each spreadsheet is described on page one of that testimony. |

A zipped file containing TW et al. LR-1 and the three Excel spreadsheet files that comprise TW et al. LR-2 are also attached to the on-line version of this Notice filed with the Commission.

In response to an informal request, Time Warner provided Mitchell's workpapers to Postal Service counsel on January 14 and indicated that it would provide Stralberg's

workpapers when they became available. In order to make these materials equally available to all interested participants, Time Warner is today depositing them at the Commission as library references. Pending issuance by the Commission of a "notice of a proceeding to be determined on the record with an opportunity for . . . a hearing," pursuant to section 17(a) of the rules of practice, these materials are submitted as category 6 library references ("All Other Material") within the meaning of rule 31(b)(2). Their purpose is to facilitate understanding and evaluation of the cost and rate design testimony proffered by the Complainants.

Upon a determination by the Commission to issue a notice of proceeding pursuant to section 17(a), Complainants would expect to file a notice recharacterizing these materials as category 2 library references ("Witness Foundational Material") and designating witnesses Mitchell and Stralberg as prepared to respond to discovery concerning them and to sponsor them into evidence at the request of the Commission, the Postal Service, or any other participant in the proceeding.
