UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE NOTICE OF FILING
OMITTED ELECTRONIC PAGES FROM ATTACHMENT C TO REQUEST
(February 26, 2004)

The United States Postal Service hereby gives notice that it is filing 27 pages of electronic material that were omitted from the electronic version of Attachment C to the Request, filed February 25, 2004. These pages were omitted from the original electronic version because repeated attempts either did not complete the Filing Online upload or they did not display properly after an apparently successful upload.

The pages consist of Postal Service Certified Financial Statements for the years ending on September 30 of 2002 and 2003. Pursuant to the Rules of Practice, the Request was filed in both electronic and hard copy versions, with the omission affecting only the electronic version. The omitted pages were made available to counsel only in hard copy form. They were duly scanned and (character) recognized in preparation for electronic filing; moreover, the scanned pages were fully usable on Postal Service computers with their text fully searchable. After repeated attempts to upload the entire Request as a single PDF, and after repeated discussions with Commission staff, the problem with the upload was identified as relating to the financial statements. They

were accordingly excised from the electronic version (which then uploaded properly) with the expectation that another approach to the electronic filing would be sought.

This pleading accordingly gives notice that the missing electronic pages are now being provided. (The electronic copy was creating using methods different from yesterday's.)
